On behalf of the Silver Heels Riding Club Board of Directors welcome to the 2020 Show Season! In order to comply with current NH State regulations we are asking for your cooperation in adhering to the current re-opening guidelines put forth from the State of NH. Under the direction of the Department of Health and Human Services we have put together the following protocols that will allow us to stay in compliance with State requirements.

We appreciate your cooperation and understanding and ask that you please share these with anyone who will be attending shows this season. These guidelines are subject to change as needed to continue to comply with state guidelines. If you have any questions, please don't hesitate to reach out.

### **Covid-19 Horse Show Protocols-June 2020 (*Subject to Updates*)**

**Shows are open to SHRC members and/or NH residents ONLY**

#### **Show Office Protocols**

- **Mandatory SHRC waiver must be signed and received.** The waiver can be found on the Show Day tab of our website. Please print and bring with you. A staff member will be present to collect forms as you enter the show grounds. We must receive a waiver for each person coming onto the property.
- **Entries MUST be submitted electronically via our website, [www.silverheelsridingclub.com](http://www.silverheelsridingclub.com), or email, [shrcentries@yahoo.com](mailto:shrcentries@yahoo.com). NO PAPER ENTRIES OR MAILED IN ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED. Entries received after 5pm on the Friday prior to shows will be considered post entries and will be subject to a \$15.00 post entry fee.** Coggins, registration forms, and parental release forms may also be uploaded with your entry on our website or attached to your entry email. **NO EXCEPTIONS TO THIS!**
- Day of ads and scratches are to be texted to Amanda at (603) 799-6021. Please include name, back number, and class number.
- Only Office staff is allowed inside of the show booth. A tent will be set up for necessary transactions.
- We ask that only one representative from each barn come to check in. Trainer packets with numbers, class lists, and patterns will be available and will be sorted alphabetically by trainer name. The representative should bring open checks. **Packets will not be given out without payment.**

#### **Show Rings**

- **Warm Up Ring**

- Only the trainer, rider, and 1 support person per rider are permitted in either section of the ring.
- The warm up ring will be divided into 2 sections; Walk/Trot/Canter and Walk/Trot/Showmanship
- **Show Rings**
  - There will be no congregating at the in gate. Please do not come to the gate until the class prior to yours is underway in the ring.
  - We will use the gate nearest the barn in Ring 1 as an entrance and riders will be asked to exit at the gate nearest the warm up ring.

### **Ribbons**

- Ribbons and trophies will not be presented in the rings. They will be available upon completion of the class at a designated awards table.

### **Best Practices**

- Please leave extra space between trailers when parking to accommodate the need for more space between persons while at the trailer.
- Hand washing stations and sanitizer will be available on the grounds.
- Only exhibitors and necessary support people will be allowed on show grounds; no additional spectators.
- Please practice social distancing throughout the show grounds.
- No congregating around show rings. Please maintain 6' of distance along the rail.
- Masks are to be worn when checking in, checking out, or whenever approaching show staff or coming within 6' of others on the grounds.
